

CAPITAL MONTESSORI SCHOOL FEES, 2010

Fees

There is a non-refundable \$100 registration fee.

Tuition fees are payable each term and are due 2 weeks after the first day of term.

3-4 year olds' programme

Capital Montessori has adopted the 20 Hours ECE for 3-4 year olds brought in by the government in 2007. A flat fee is charged for the hours over and above the 20 Hours ECE, ranging from 1-9 extra hours. The fee is reviewed each year.

With attestation for 20 hours ECE: 10 week term: \$400 fee per term

Without attestation for 20 hours ECE: 10 week term: \$700 - \$980 (depending on number of hours).

5 year olds' programme

10 week term: \$400 fee per term

Bond and Enrolment Fee

Parents who have accepted a place at Capital for their child will need to pay a refundable Bond which equates to half a term's fee (currently \$200) and an Enrolment Fee of \$400 in order to confirm their place at Capital. Payment will be required at least a term before the start date. The Enrolment Fee is non-refundable but will be credited towards the first term's fees. The bond is refunded when the child leaves Capital or can be held for a sibling.

Childcare Subsidy available from WINZ

Assistance with paying fees may be available through the Childcare Subsidy run by WINZ. This subsidy is related to the level of parental income.
